

Student Learning Engagement 2022 2023







While our students have historically excelled in Provincial Achievement Tests, recent results have shown a decline. This decrease may be attributed to implementing new curriculums, the increasing prevalence of split-grade classrooms, and piloting the Vretta assessment format.

To address these challenges, we are actively implementing strategies, including alternating curriculum delivery in split-grade classes and providing additional student support. Our school-based learning communities, focusing on literacy, enhance our staff's capacity to teach the new curriculum. By offering targeted interventions, timely accommodations, and ongoing professional development, we strive to create a supportive learning environment where all students can thrive.

Golden Hills School Division and École Brentwood continue to provide research-based interventions and professional development to ensure our staff is equipped with effective teaching practices. Our collaborative and strategic approach focuses on maintaining high standards and delivering an exceptional learning experience.

Parental Involvement






Citizenship

- Continue efforts to build an outdoor classroom space








